Instant petition has been filed under Section 439(2) of Cr.PC for cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to Respondents No.2 to 5 vide order 06.08.2020 (Annexure P-2) subsequently made absolute vide order dated 02.09.2020 (Annexure P-3) passed by Addl Sessions Judge, Moga in FIR No.05 dated 23.07.2020 under Section 406, 498-A, 420, 120-B IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station PS NRI, District Moga (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks cancellation of bail granted by the Court below vide order dated 06.08.2020 primarily on two counts i.e.

firstly, the complainant was being threatened by the respondents, who had since been extended the concession of bail, to withdraw their statements against them;
and that the learned Lower Court had wrongly observed that the dispute between the parties emanates out of a matrimonial dispute.

Heard.

Once the concession of bail has been extended to an accused,

the Court act with a great deal of circumspection in ordering cancellation of bail unless a seemingly perverse order has been passed by the Court below or the accused has violated and breached the conditions of bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has failed to satisfy this Court *qua* either of the aforementioned.

In the circumstances, no ground is made out for cancellation of bail granted by the Lower Court vide order dated 06.08.2020.

Dismissed.
