Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.152 dated 21.09.2020 under Sections 451, 323, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC, Sections 3 & 4 of the Punjab Protection of Medicare Service Persons and Medicare Service Institutions(Prevention of Violence and Damage to Property) Bill, 2008 and under Section 51 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, registered at Police Station Khanna, City-2, District Khanna.

At this stage, Dr. Anmol Rattan Sidhu, Sr. Advocate with Mr. Sukhcharan Singh Gill, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and submits that on 28.09.2020, offence under Section 3(A)(i)(ii)(iii)(iv) of the Epidemic Diseases(Amendment) Ordinance, 2020 has been added in the case.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present petition, however, with liberty to file a fresh one by incorporating the newly added sections in the FIR.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty, as aforesaid.
