MEENAKSHI I. MEHTA (ORAL)

By way of the instant petition, the petitioners have sought the indulgence of this Court for the issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect their life and personal liberty as they apprehend threat to the same at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7 because they (petitioners) have solemnized their marriage against the wishes of these respondents. A further prayer has also been made for issuance of direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to ensure that respondents No. 4 to 7 do not harass or interfere in their (petitioners') married life. It has been further mentioned in the petition that petitioner No.1 has already moved a representation (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.2-the Senior Superintendent of Police Rural, Jalandhar, on 28.09.2020, in this regard.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Bhavna Gupta, Deputy Advocate

General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioners restricts his prayer to issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-4).

Learned counsel for the State has no objection for the same.

Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the legality and validity of the marriage, as stated to have been solemnized between the petitioners, respondent No.2-the Senior Superintendent of Police Rural, Jalandhar, is hereby directed to look into the said representation (Annexure P-4) and if it is found that the petitioners genuinely deserve any protection, then to take appropriate action in accordance with law.

This petition stands disposed of.
