The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.107 dated 12.6.2020, registered at Police Station Garshankar, District Hoshiarpur, under Section 22 of NDPS Act, 1985.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner confines his prayer to grant of interim bail to the petitioner till the date of receipt of report of the FSL.

Learned State counsel concedes that the report of the FSL has still not been received.

Custody certificate dated 6.10.2020 has been presented in Court today and the same is taken on record. According to this certificate, there is no other criminal case under the NDPS Act, 1985 pending against the petitioner.

In view of the fact that the FSL report is still awaited and that there is no other criminal case under the NDPS Act, 1985 pending against the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to partially allow this petition. Accordingly, the petition is partially allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail till the receipt of the FSL report, on his furnishing

bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned. The petitioner is directed to surrender before the Court concerned, on the day, the report of the FSL is presented.
