1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the Contempt Petition under Sections 10 / 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for not complying with the order of this Court Annexure P/1 dated 11.09.2020, in CWP No.14205 of 2020, in case titled as Budh Singh vs. State of Haryana and others.

3. Learned counsel contends that vide order dated 11.09.2020, CWP No.14205 of 2020, was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner and to take suitable action, if warranted, within ten days from 11.09.2020, but despite lapse of aforementioned period of time, needful had not been done.

4. Notice of motion to respondent No.4 only.

5. Mr. Rohit Arya, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.4 and has placed on record copy of order dated 18.09.2020, passed by respondent No.4, in terms of order of this Court dated 11.09.2020.

Copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.
