Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had applied for the post of 'Aganwadi Helper' in Village Danduwal and that although as per the prescribed conditions the applicant has to be a resident of the Village where the Aganwadi exists but somehow the respondents have appointed one Anju Rani (respondent No.4) which is not even a resident of the said Village Danduwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that although he had served legal notice dated 4.8.2020 (Annexure P-9) upon respondent No.1 but the same has not been decided so far.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and while refraining from making any expression as regards merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to State of Punjab through its Principal Secretary, Department of Social Security and Women and Child Development (respondent No.1) as well as to District Program Officer, Women Social Security and Child Development Department Punjab (respondent No.2) to look into the matter and to ensure that legal notice dated 4.8.2020 (Annexure P-9) is disposed off in accordance with law expeditiously preferably within a period of 3 months from today.
