1. This petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to refund the security amount i.e. 6,94,898/- deposited by the petitioner with the official respondents in regard to E-tender/M.C/Tapa/2016-17.

2 Learned counsel for the petitioner states that during the pendency of this petition the petitioner has moved a representation to respondent No.3 to refund the abvoesaid security amount.

3. Learned State counsel states that in one similar case bearing **CWP No.12847-2020** titled **Navdeep Singh vs. State of Punjab and others** decided by this Court on 10.11.2020 it had directed to decide the representation within four weeks and states that he has no objection if the same decision is given in this writ petition.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that she is satisfied with this due course of action.

5. In the circumstances, we direct respondent No.3 to decide the representation filed by the petitioner within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order by passing a speaking order thereon and in case any amount is due the same shall be released to the petitioner within four weeks thereafter. In case due amount is not released the petitioner would be entitled to claim the same with interest at the rate of 8% per annum from the due date till the date of ultimate payment.

6. Petition stands disposed of.

7. Since the main case has been decided, the pending application, if any(s), also stands disposed of.
