On 19.05.2017, this Court passed the following order:-

“Petitioner has questioned the validity of transfer order dated 15.05.2017 by which he has been transferred from Govt. Polytechnic, Ambala City to Govt. Polytechnic for Women, Faridabad, in place of 5th respondent. It is evident from the order of transfer that at the behest of 5th respondent petitioner has been displaced from Ambala. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is working at Ambala since 14.12.2015. Order reflects that it is in the public interest but no reasons have been assigned.

Notice of motion for 12.09.2017.

Operation of Annexure P2 dated 15.05.2017, is stayed insofar

as petitioner and 5th respondent are concerned, till the next date of hearing.”

Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner is working in Amabala since 2015 and has completed 04 years of service, as this Court had granted interim stay to the petitioner. His transfer order has been stayed as he was transferred within 02 years of service. Thus, now the petitioner has no right to stay in Ambala and respondent No. 5 who is widow and suffering from neurological disease i.e Epilepsy is liable to be transferred to Ambala.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
