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**Manjari Nehru Kaul, J (Oral):**

This is a petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to quash the order dated 30.03.2015 (Annexure P-17) and final seniority list dated 14.6.2016 (Annexure P-20), wherein, the seniority of the petitioner has been fixed at Sr. No.317.

At the outset, learned Senior counsel Mr. D. S. Patwalia, assisted by Mr. Adityajeet Singh, Advocate, representing the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the petition is disposed of with a direction to the official respondent No.1 to consider his case as has

been done in the case of similarly situated persons namely Rahul Gupta at S.No. 267 and Kamal Kumar at S.No. 274 in the Revised Final Seniority list of PCS (Executive Branch) (Annexure P-20). He further submits that a representation in this regard would be filed by him to the authorities concerned within a period of one week from today.

In view of the limited prayer made by learned Senior counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 – State of Punjab through its Chief Secretary to look into the representation, as and when it is filed by the petitioner and thereafter pass an appropriate speaking order in accordance with law, after giving an opportunity of hearing to all concerned including those, who may be affected by the said order, as expeditiously as possible.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
