Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the present quashing petition has been filed on the basis of compromise.

The offence involved is under Section 306 IPC. The same cannot be quashed on the basis of compromise being against the public policy.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that not only is there a compromise, but even otherwise no offence is made out, and therefore prays for withdrawing the present petition with liberty to file fresh one.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
