The present criminal writ petition is for seeking direction to respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from respondents No.3, 5 and 6 and for registration of the case against respondents No.5 and 6.

From the contents of the petition, it is evidently clear that the petitioner claims himself to be a Non-Resident Indian (NRI) and respondents No.5 and 6 are alleged to have committed theft of the items of the petitioner but respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur has refused to lodge the FIR despite the representations addressed to Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1), Director General of Police, Punjab (P-2) and Deputy Inspector General of Police, Jalandhar Range, Jalandhar (P-3).

There is no denial of the fact that the State of Punjab has constituted an NRI Commission for redressal of the grievances of the NRIs and therefore, it would be advisable for the petitioner to approach the said Commission and to represent before it.

In view of the above, the present criminal writ petition stands disposed of with such direction.
