The petitioner has filed the present writ petition after an unexplained delay of 27 years from the date when he was not allegedly allowed to resume his work/job. The petitioner claims that he was appointed as Baledar on daily wages basis, in the year 1988 and after performing his work for a period of five years, he was not allowed to resume work on 1.3.1993.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has a continuous cause of action.

This Court has considered the submission. The petitioner was admittedly not allowed to resume his work on 1.3.1993. The cause of action arose to the petitioner in the year 1993. After a period of 27 years, the limitation for filing a suit has also elapsed. Hence, the present writ petition is dismissed on the ground of delay and latches.
