The petitioners are employees of MARKFED. In departmental proceedings initiated against them, two separate orders for recovery from their salary have been passed. Against one order, a statutory revision dated 02.07.2020 (Annexure P-6) is pending and against the second order, a statutory appeal dated 17.08.2020 (Annexure P-10) is pending. The grievance of the petitioners is that recovery is being effected from their salary without deciding their statutory appeal/revision and along with which an application for stay has also been filed. Nobody has put in appearance on behalf of the MARKFED despite a copy having been given in advance to the Standing Counsel.

The writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Revisional as well as Appellate Authority to decide the stay application filed with the pending revision/appeal within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Till then, no recovery is to be effected from the petitioners.
