The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.497 dated 08.04.2020 under Sections 457 and 380 IPC registered at Police Station City Panipat, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 09.05.2020 and his role is similar to co-accused Imran, who has already been admitted on regular bail by this Court vide order dated 28.09.2020 passed in ***CRM-M-29330 of 2020*** titled as ***Imran Versus State of Haryana.***

Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforesaid fact, however, she states that there are other cases registered against the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 09.05.2020 and co-accused Imran has already been admitted on bail by this Court, this Court finds that no fruitful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner in further custody.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

It is made clear that in case the petitioner is found indulged in any other case, the prosecution shall be at liberty to seek cancellation of his bail.

The observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case and the trial Court shall decide the case without being influenced with these observations in any manner.
