The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to decide the representation-cum-legal notice dated 14.09.2020 given by the petitioners to respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the order dated 01.09.2020 passed by this Court in another case, i.e. CWP No.13229 of 2020, the petitioners have already submitted a representation to the authorities qua their grievance. However, the authorities are not taking a final decision thereon. Hence, it is submitted by counsel that the petitioners would be satisfied, at this stage, if the respondents are directed to take a final decision on the representation/ legal notice dated 14.09.2020 at Annexure P.3 within a time bound manner.

Learned State Counsel submits that State is not averse to consideration of the case of the petitioners in the right earnest and with due promptitude.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take a conscious final decision and to pass a speaking order on the legal notice/ representation of the petitioners within a period of two months from today.
