AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Counsel for the petitioner states that the present writ petition in part has been rendered infructuous as the petitioner has been declared eligible for consideration for appointment to the post of Sikhya Service Provider (PTI) under Ex-Serviceman Dependent Category. He, therefore, contends that the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner for appointment within some specified time and to grant the consequential benefits, if any, from the date the persons lower in merit have been appointed.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to the Chairman, Recruitment Board-cum-Principal Secretary, School Education Department, Punjab-respondent No. 1 and The Directorate, Directorate-cum-District General School Education

Recruitment Department of School Education-respondent No. 2 to consider the claim of the petitioner for appointment to the post of Sikhya Service Provider (PTI) within a period of four weeks and in case the petitioner is selected, issue the appointment letter along with the consequential benefits (notional), if any, from the date the person lower in merit than the petitioner was so appointed within a further period of four weeks.
