Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to provide protection of life and liberty to the petitioner, and to restrain the private respondent Nos. 5 and 6 not to harass or interfere in the peaceful life of the petitioner.

Status report filed by the counsel for Union Territory, Chandigarh is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at an appropriate place.

In the circumstance, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh to look into the representations dated 10.7.2020(Annexure P-1,), 1.9.2020 (Annexure P-2) and 24.9.2020 (Annexure P-4) and the threat perception at

the hands of private respondent Nos. 5 and 6 and take appropriate action.

In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, the petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2 —Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh to look into the representations dated 10.7.2020 (Annexure P-1), 1.9.2020 (Annexure P-2) and 24.9.2020 (Annexure P-4) respectively and take appropriate action, if any, required in accordance with law at the earliest preferably within a period of one month from today.
