 In compliance with the last order dated 30.1.2020, ASI Om Parkash has produced the detenue Chanda @ Chandni wife of petitioner No.1-Suresh Yadav, alongwith minor children, namely, Muskan, aged about 12 years; Khusi, about 8 years; and Sachan, aged about 06 years.

 In the pre-lunch session, all of them were referred to the Mediator for recording their respective statements.

 In her statement, Chanda @ Chandni, it has come that her marriage was solemnized with petitioner No.1-Suresh Yadav on 20.6.2006 and out of this wedlock, three children were born. Due to some dispute, she has left the house along with the minor children about 01 year and 08 months ago. She has further stated that she is ready to join her matrimonial home and start living with her husband provided that he does not fight with her them and live affectionately and lovingly. It is also stated that she has apprehension that he will make nuisance at home after taking alcohol and if he undertakes not to create any such nuisance, she is ready to reside with him.

In his statement petitioner No.1-Suresh Yadav, it is stated that he is ready to take back her wife Chanda @ Chandni and undertake to take care of the entire family and maintain congenial/ cordial atmosphere in the family.

In view of the same, as petitioner-Suresh Yadav has stated before the Court that he is ready to take her wife and children with him from the Court premises itself. Allowed to do so.

According, this petition is disposed of.

Liberty is granted to the parties to stay as per their wishes.

It is, however, made clear that if the petitioner-Suresh Yadav will fail to take care of her wife Chanda @ Chandni and children, it will be open for Chanda @ Chandni to approach to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Rewari for redressal of her grievances.
