The petitioners are serving as Head Constables in Punjab Police after having being recruited as Special Police Officers and having being absorbed in service. Their grievance is that now, their service is governed by the old GPF Scheme and the contributions already made to the CPF Scheme need to be refunded. In this regard, a legal notice dated 23.6.2020 (Annexure P-6) has already been submitted, but no action has been taken thereupon, till date.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that for a just and final decision, in this case, respondent No.5 need not to be served.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Monica Chhibber Sharma, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4 and waives service.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to seek a reply.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice dated 23.6.2020 (Annexure P-6) by passing a speaking order, in accordance with law, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
