Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondent No.2 to resolve the grievance of petitioner which is filed by way of representation dated 25.08.2020 (P-5); with a further prayer to direct respondent no.2 to issue Arms Licence to petitioner as there is a threat to his life and liberty.

At the outset, instead of pressing the petition on merits, learned counsel for petitioner submits that he would be satisfied in case the representation dated 25.08.2020 (P-5) submitted by petitioner is decided by the competent authority on some early date.

Prayer seems to be justified.

Notice of motion.

Mr. R.S. Dhull, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Learned State counsel is not averse to the innocuous prayer made by petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the case; this Court deems it appropriate to dispose off present writ petition with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 25.08.2020 (P-5), if the same is pending, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, expeditiously, but not later than four weeks from today.
