This writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari, quashing the final result declared on 3.9.2020. It has been pleaded that the petitioners pursuant to a recruitment notice dated 20.6.2019, inviting applications for 4858 posts of Clerks of Group C in various Departments/Boards/Corporations, submitted an application. Petitioner no.1 states that he belongs to Scheduled Caste category whereas petitioner no.3 claims that she belongs to Backward class category. It is being claimed that although the petitioners have secured higher marks than the cut off marks as per the OMR sheet and they were also invited for document verification, however, their names are not included in the final list of successful candidates. He further submits that the petitioners have submitted a representation dated 27.9.2020, to the respondent no.2, in this regard.

Sh. Samarth Sagar, Addl. AG, Haryana, has appeared pursuant to supply of advance copy of the writ petition. He submits that let the Haryana Staff Selection Commission be permitted to consider the representation of the petitioners.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, particularly, when in

the facts of the present case, the record shall be required to be examined, it is considered appropriate to direct the Secretary, Haryana Staff Selection Commission, to look into the grievance of the petitioners in their representation dated 27.9.2020 and pass a speaking order thereon, after granting an opportunity of hearing to the petitioners through video conferencing, within one month.
