This petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been moved seeking issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents No.1 to 3 to register FIR on complaint dated 18.12.2019 (Annexure P/1) given by petitioner to respondent No.2, against respondent No.5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation on 18.12.2019 to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural), copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/1, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. A.A. Pathak, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural), to look into and decide representation dated 18.12.2019 (Annexure P/1) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within four weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
