It has been stated by learned counsel for the petitioner that an FIR bearing No.69 dated 14.06.2020, under Sections 323, 324, 326, 506, 148, 149 IPC has been registered at Police Station Fattu Dyinga, District Kapurthala at the instance of the petitioner against the private respondents. The private respondents are threatening the petitioner to enter into compromise and he is apprehending danger to his life and liberty. A representation (Annexure P-2) has already been submitted to respondent No.3 but no action has been taken thereupon.
