The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.37 dated 03.03.2019 under Section 22 of NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Lambi, Tehsil Malout and District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

[2] The petitioner was arrested on 03.03.2019, he has thereafter remained in detention ever since. So far 07 out of the 16 prosecution witnesses have been examined. There is no record of the petitioner's involvement in any other case under the NDPS Act.

[3] Considering the long detention undergone by the petitioner, he is ordered to be released on regular bail in the above mentioned FIR, subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
