Petitioners claim that they have attained majority and married against the wishes of their family members. Apprehending threat to their life and liberty, they have filed the present petition for protection.

Petitioners claim to have submitted a representation (Annexure P-4) dated 23.09.2020 in this regard to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar Commissionerate-respondent No.2.

Heard. Record perused.

Notice of motion to the office of Advocate General, Punjab.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Sidakmeet Sandhu, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State. Copy supplied.

The petitioner No.1 has placed on record only the copy of her

affidavit (Annexures P-1) and petitioner No.2 has placed on record only the copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-2) as proof of their age.

Two photographs on two sheets as Annexure P-3 have also been placed on record .

This petition is disposed of with a direction to the SHO, Police Station, Division No.5, District Jalandhar Commissionerate-respondent No.3, to look into the representation Annexure P-4 dated 23.09.2020 and ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not be treated as stamp of the Court about the marriage of the parties and no opinion regarding the validity of the marriage has been expressed.
