The petitioners are the accused in FIR No. 98 dated 06.06.2014 on the file of Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar, registered under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC. By way of this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C, they seek quashing of the said FIR.

The basis for this prayer is the compromise deed dated 24.09.2020 executed by and between the petitioners and the second respondent-complainant, at whose behest the subject FIR was registered.

Mr. Abhishek Sharma, learned counsel, entered appearance for the second respondent-complainant and filed his power of attorney. He affirms the factum of the compromise and states that his client has no objection to the subject FIR being quashed.

Mr. Gaurav Garg Dhuriwala, learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, would state on instructions that no other FIR has been registered against the petitioners.

As the offence arises out of a commercial dispute of a private nature and as the parties seem to have amicably worked out their differences, no purpose would be served in wasting the time and resources of the State in prosecuting this case to its inevitable and futile conclusion.

The petition is allowed. FIR No. 98 dated 06.06.2024 on the file of Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar, and all proceedings relating thereto are accordingly quashed.
