ARUN MONGA, J. (ORAL)

At the outset, Mr. L.S.Sidhu, Advocate appears for respondent No.4 and submits that per his instructions, petitioner No.2 is guilty of serious concealment, inasmuch as, he is not only already married but also have two children born out of the wedlock. Yet, without disclosing his previous marriage, he has misled petitioner No.1 to get married with him.

Confronted with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that per his instructions, it is first marriage of both the petitioners.

Matter was passed over once to give an opportunity to the learned counsel for the petitioners to contact petitioner No.2 on telephone. But when the matter is now taken up in the second round, he says that he is unable to contact petitioner no.2.

Be that as it may, present petition is dismissed on the basis of statement of learned counsel appearing for respondent No.4.

However, petitioners shall be at liberty to file appropriate application, in case, the said statement is incorrect.
