This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent Nos. 1 and 2 to allow the petitioners to submit the permission-cum-admission form (PCA form) and for further direction to accept the permission-cum-admission form of the petitioners and to permit them to appear in the upcoming examination of diploma in Pharmacy.

A perusal of the petition reveals that no representation has been made by the petitioners to the official respondents with respect to their grievance. In the circumstances, no ground is made out for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus.

Learned State counsel has, however on instructions informed the Court that the petitioners would be given a special chance to take their examination in December, 2020.
