MCG/ZTO/2015/2348 dated 26.06.2015 issued by respondent No.3.

Learned counsel for the Municipal Corporation has placed on
record instructions dated 08.08.2017 whereby a decision has been taken that
while issuing trade license, the Municipal Corporation will insist only on the
following documents:-

1. Identification documents proof
2. Lease deed/legal occupancy
3. PAN/TAN/TIN No.

These instructions are taken on record as Annexure R-1.

Keeping in view these instructions, memo dated 26.06.2015 has
become irrelevant now and Municipal Corporation is bound by the above
said instructions for future as well.
