Hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The petitioner-Lalit Kumar @ Laddi son of Acchru Ram prays for grant of bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.0109, dated 20.07.2020, registered under Section 148/149/307/323/427/452/506 IPC, at Police Station Kalka.

The petitioner is in detention since 22.07.2020.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 24.07.2020 as no further police remand of the petitioner was sought for.

Sh. Chetan Sharma, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, has admitted that the offence under Section 307 IPC stands deleted by the prosecution.

It is also not disputed that the dispute is with regard to immovable property situated in the village. The first informant claims that he is the owner thereof.

On completion of the investigation, the challan qua co-accused of the petitioner has already been presented. The conclusion of the trial is likely to take time.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and without commenting on the merits of the case, it is considered appropriate to direct release of the petitioner on regular bail subject to furnishing of adequate surety to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed with the aforesaid directions.
