1. Result of the petitioner for the post of LDC in general category in UHBVNL/DHBVNL against advertisement No.03/2016, category No.03, has been produced in sealed cover, which on opening reveals the petitioner to have secured 93 out of 200 marks as against 113/117 marks obtained by the last selected candidate and 100/110 marks obtained by the last candidate in the waiting list in UHBVNL/DHBVNL respectively.
