Reply on behalf of the respondents has been filed by the learned State counsel and the same is taken on record.

In the present petition, the allegation of the petitioner is that she and her family members are being falsely implicated in the cases of the recovery of the spurious liquor at the behest of the certain local contractors and in connivance with the officials of the Excise Department.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner who is innocent, is being involved though, no illegality has been committed by the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that due to the harassment extended by the respondents, the younger son of the petitioner had committed suicide and an FIR No.84 dated 14.08.2020 was registered in this regard but no action is being taken by the respondents-State to investigate the said FIR. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner had given a representation on 21.09.2020 (Annexure P-6)

to the authorities but no outcome of the same has been informed to the petitioner.

After the notice of motion was issued, the respondents have filed a detailed reply. In the detailed reply, the respondents have submitted that the matter has been investigated in respect of FIR No.84 dated 14.08.2020 and the cancellation report has been prepared for the submission before the competent Court of law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise all the objections before the competent Court of law where the cancellation report is to be submitted by the police, raising all his grievance for the appreciation of the said Court, as and when the cancellation report is submitted.

The present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty, as prayed for.
