S.N. SATYANARAYANA, J.(ORAL)

The petitioner herein is seeking certain directions to respondent/Institution where she had applied for a seat to pursue her studies in Master in Public Health Course for July 2020 Session.

It is stated that though she secured 10th rank in the test, she was not selected. In the present writ petition it is contended that out of 22 seats available only 17 seats are filled up. So far as, admission under the Sponsored category, ST Category and Physically Handicapped Category, three, one & one seats respectively are not filled up and same are lying vacant. It is in this background she has filed this writ petition seeking certain directions to respondent-PGIMER to consider her candidature for one of the seats available.

We do see that there is no legal right existing in her to seek

such directions. Further, allotment of seats by respondents No. 1 and 2

/Institution is based on certain parameters and criteria which they have framed for themselves and it is seen that the Court has no business to interfere with the same and set a precedent, which would further create problem for filling up of the seats by the said Institution.

Therefore, in the aforesaid situation, we are of the considered opinion that the present writ petition does not merit consideration and it is not even a case where notice is required to be given to respondents No. 1 and 2.

Accordingly, this writ petition is dismissed.

A copy of this order is directed to be sent to respondents No.1 and 2 to ensure that there shall not be a further attempt to seek any prayer suppressing dismissal of this writ petition.
