AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court with a grievance that the life and liberty as also her property are in danger at the hands of respondent Nos.5 to 8. It is contended that the petitioner had been approaching the official respondents for redressal of her grievance but nothing fruitful has come. She has even submitted a representation dated 26.02.2020 (Annexure P-1) to the Deputy Commissioner, District Amritsar-respondent No.2, highlighting her grievance but despite her various visits to the office, she is unable to know the fate of the same.

Counsel contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Deputy Commissioner, District Amritsar-respondent No.2, to look into the representation dated 26.02.2020 (Annexure P-1) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Deputy Commissioner, District Amritsar-respondent No.2, to look into the representation dated 26.02.2020 (Annexure P-1) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
