**ANIL KSHETARPAL, J(Oral)**

On 05.10.2020, the following order was passed:-

*“Hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.*

*The petitioner, father-in-law of the deceased, prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in a criminal case arising from FIR No.249, dated 25.08.2020, registered under Section 306/323/34/506 IPC, at Police Station Uklana, District Hisar.*

*As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner's son-in-law committed suicide as the deceased and his wife had a fight. It is alleged that the petitioner and his daughter were pressurizing the deceased-Manoj, to transfer his agricultural land in the name of his wife.*

*Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the ingredients of the offence under Section 306 IPC, read with Section 107 IPC, are not made out. He further submits that the entire family of the petitioner has been falsely implicated.*

*Notice of motion for 28.10.2020.*

*On the request of this Court, Mr. Chetan Sharma, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State.*

*In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction*

*of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”*

Mr. Chetan Sharma, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, on instructions from ASI Satpal, has submitted that the petitioner in this case has joined the investigation, cooperated and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

Keeping in view the statement made by Sh. Chetan Sharma, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, the interim order dated 05.10.2020, passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
