The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.15 dated 08.03.2020, under Sections 420, 506 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Valtaha, district Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that she along with other accused had taken money from the complainant for sending him abroad. He further contends that the entire payment is alleged to have been made in cash and the complainant has disclosed the source of ₹2 lacs which had been transferred in his account by the commission agent and the source of the rest of the money is not disclosed. He also contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated just because she is the wife of co-accused, namely, Gurwinder Singh. The petitioner is a lady with two minor children aged 07 years and 09 years. She is not involved in any other case.

This Court, by the order dated 05.10.2020, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel has filed the status report by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Valtaha, Camp at Bhikhiwind, District Taran Taran wherein it is stated that although the petitioner has joined investigation but the recovery has to be effected from her and she has not disclosed the whereabouts of the co-accused.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 05.10.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
