The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.126 dated 18.06.2020, under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Ding, district Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and no recovery has been effected from him. The petitioner has been arraigned as an accused on the statement of co-accused, namely, Kuldeep @ Sandhi from whom 480 capsules containing Tramadol were allegedly recovered. He also contends that the petitioner is in custody for about three months since his arrest on 10.07.2020 and is not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions, contends that although challan has been filed but charges are yet to be framed.

Heard through video conferencing.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is in custody for about 03 months, he is not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act, nothing has been recovered from him; the COVID-19 pandemic, and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
