GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of lockdown due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Harpreet Kaur, stated to be aged 23 years, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 & 3 to initiate appropriate legal action against respondents No.4 to 14 and their accomplices involved in causing injuries to the petitioner and her family members, out of which, one injury to the Aunt of the petitioner namely Smt. Rajbir Kaur wife of Sh. Gurdial Singh, has been declared as grievous in nature. It is further prayed that a direction may kindly be issued to respondent No.3 to get medico legally examined father of the petitioner namely Desa Singh who has been kept in police confinement since 25.09.2020 i.e. the date of incident as he has sustained sharp edged weapon head injury.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the above said grievance, the petitioner had filed a representation dated 26.09.2020 (Annexure P-6) before The Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, but till date, no decision has been taken.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. P.S. Walia, Assistant AG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

In view of the above, without commenting upon merits of the case, the present petition is **disposed of** with a direction that in case, the petitioner approaches the police authorities concerned, with above representation (Annexure P-6) or any other representation being filed before the Competent Authority concerned, the same shall be got examined by The Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran (respondent No.2), as expeditiously as possible preferably within two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order, in accordance with law and necessary steps as may be warranted under the facts and circumstances of the case, be taken thereupon forthwith.

A copy of this order be sent by the Registry to The Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran (respondent No.2), through e-mail or any other mode, so as to enable the said authority to do the needful expeditiously.

Ordered accordingly.
