The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of lockdown due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Balvir Singh, stated to be aged 55 years, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of direction to the respondents No.1 to 3 to take legal action against accused persons i.e. respondents No.4 & 5 and other persons in DDR No.031 dated 10.10.2019, registered at Police Station Tibba, Ludhiana and present the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. before the learned Magistrate.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. P.S. Walia, Assistant AG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the above said

grievance, the petitioner had filed a representation dated 02.11.2019 (Annexure P-2) before The Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, but till date, no decision has been taken.

In view of the above, without commenting upon merits of the case, the present petition is **disposed of** with a direction that in case, the petitioner approaches the police authorities concerned, with above representation (Annexure P-2) or any other representation being filed before the Competent Authority concerned, the same shall be got examined by The Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana (respondent No.2), as expeditiously as possible preferably within two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order, in accordance with law and necessary steps as may be warranted under the facts and circumstances of the case, be taken thereupon forthwith.

A copy of this order be sent by the Registry to The Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana (respondent No.2), through e-mail or any other mode, so as to enable the said authority to do the needful expeditiously.

Disposed of accordingly.
