GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of lockdown due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioners-Harvinder Singh and three others, have jointly filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 & 2 in FIR No.78 dated 11.06.2020, registered under Sections 323, 325, 506, 148 & 149 of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Samana, District Patiala, to take appropriate action against respondents No.5 to 10, who caused the grievous injuries to petitioners No.1 & 2 with a further prayer for cancellation of DDR No.22 dated 14.06.2020, registered under Sections 323, 324 & 34 of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station City Samana, District Patiala, which was lodged by respondent No.11 as a cross case.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that for the same/similar grievance as made in the petition, the petitioners had filed a representation dated 10.09.2020 (Annexure P-4) before The Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, District Patiala, but till date, no decision has been taken.

On a question put by the Court, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in the present case, no enquiry till date, has been ordered or conducted on request of either the petitioners or the respondents.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. P.S. Walia, Assistant AG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

In view of the above, without commenting upon merits of the case, the present petition is **disposed of** with a direction that in case, the petitioners approach the police authorities concerned, with above representation (Annexure P-4) or any other representation being filed before the Competent Authority concerned, the same shall be got examined by The Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, District Patiala (respondent No.2), as expeditiously as possible preferably within two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order, in accordance with law and necessary steps as may be warranted under the facts and circumstances of the case, be taken thereupon forthwith.

A copy of this order be sent by the Registry to The Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, District Patiala (respondent No.2), through e-mail or any other mode, so as to enable the said authority to do

the needful expeditiously.

Ordered accordingly.
