The petitioner has applied for the post of P.T.I. but has not been called for interview.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that according to the eligibility criteria a 'BC-A' category candidate is required to score 45% marks in the written test. The petitioner belongs to the said category and according to evaluation of her answer book based on the answer key uploaded by respondent No.3, she has scored 45% marks. Yet, she has not been called for interview. Even representation dated 29.09.2020 (Annexure P-15) has not been decided.
