GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of lockdown due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Khalsa College Lyallpur through its Principal, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to remove the *Dharna* staged by respondents No.5 to 7 and their friends, within the premises of Khalsa College Lyallpur, Jalandhar w.e.f. 15.09.2020, due to which the teaching staff is facing difficulty in delivering the lectures through video conferencing from the college premises and the students of the college are facing difficulties in the study.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the above said grievance, the petitioner had filed a representation dated 25.09.2020 (Annexure P-5) before The Deputy Commissioner, Jalandhar, but till date, no decision has

been taken.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. P.S. Walia, Assistant AG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

In view of the above, without commenting upon merits of the case, the present petition is **disposed of** with a direction that in case, the petitioner approaches the police authorities concerned, with above representation (Annexure P-5) or any other representation being filed before the Competent Authority concerned, the same shall be got examined by The Deputy Commissioner, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar (respondent No.4), as expeditiously as possible preferably within two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order, in accordance with law and necessary steps as may be warranted under the facts and circumstances of the case, be taken thereupon forthwith.

A copy of this order be sent by the Registry to The Deputy Commissioner, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar (respondent No.4), through e-mail or any other mode, so as to enable the said authority to do the needful expeditiously.

Ordered accordingly.
