During the course of hearing arguments of the two sides on the pointing out of the counsel for the State and the complainant that there is misrepresentation of facts in the petition which in fact is third regular bail application and not second as detailed therein and the fact that co-accused have been allowed bail is factually incorrect.

Faced with likely consequences, counsel for the petitioner has made statement withdrawing the present petition.
