The grievance of the petitioners in this case was with regard to the recruitment process undertaken by the Institute of Banking and Personnel Selection, Mumbai, in relation to the posts notified by Nodal Sarva Haryana Gramin Bank, Rohtak, Haryana.

In the light of the judgment dated 06.02.2020 delivered by the Supreme Court in Civil Appeal No.4455 of 2019, titled **'Rajbir Surajbhan Singh V/s. The Chairman, Institute of Banking Personnel Selection,**

Mumbai', holding to the effect that the said Institute is not an authority within the meaning of Article 12 of the Constitution of India, this writ petition is not maintainable.

The writ petition is accordingly dismissed on that ground.

The order shall not preclude the petitioners from taking recourse to alternative remedies available to them in law before the competent forum.
