This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

The petitioner has filed this writ petition for quashing show cause notice dated 02.08.2020 (Annexure P4) with the averment that a decision regarding punishment of dismissal of the petitioner from service has already been taken by the respondent – Corporation.

Learned counsel for the respondents while referring to Office Order No. 194 dated 24.11.2020 passed by the Superintending Engineer, UHBVN, Panipat submits that the matter has been re-considered by the Department and it has been decided to conduct further inquiry in the matter from the stage of examination of witnesses, therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous as clearly no action shall be taken upon the show cause notice dated 02.08.2020 (Annexure P4).

In view of the categorical stand of the Department, the present writ petition is disposed of as infructuous.

Needless to say, there is no expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
