AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners apprehend threat to their lives and liberty from respondent Nos.4 to 6 and have, therefore, highlighted this position in their representation dated 30.09.2020 (Annexure P-5) addressed to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, respondent No.2.

Counsel contends that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent Nos.2 and 3, to look into the representation dated 30.09.2020 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur and SHO, Police Station Garhshankar, District Hoshiarpur, respondent Nos.2 and 3 respectively, to look into the representation dated 30.09.2020 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law, if required.
