Case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to the outbreak of Pandemic COVID-19.

Through this petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, prayer has been made for issuance of direction to respondents to consider the candidature of the petitioner for the post of clerk keeping in view the fact that the petitioner secured 66 marks as against cut-off of 66 in EWS category.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction may be issued to the respondents to decide his claim as raised in the grievance details/representation dated 18.09.2020 (Annexure P-8), submitted online by the petitioner.

Without commenting upon the merits of this case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 18.09.2020 (Annexure P-8), the present writ

petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2-Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula to decide the representation dated 18.09.2020 (Annexure P-8) within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
