Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Status report by way of affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Jalalabad, District Fazilka, has been filed through e-mail. Print out of the same is taken on record.

The present petition has been filed by the petitioners seeking protection to their life and liberty with the averments that they performed marriage on 27.09.2020 as per Sikh rites and ceremonies against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 10 and they are apprehending threats.

Vide order dated 06.10.2020 passed by a Coordinate Bench, respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka, had been directed to look into the grievances of the petitioners as set out in the petition and also expressed in the representation dated 27.09.2020 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate action for protection of their life and liberty.

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Learned State counsel draws the attention of this Court towards the affidavit (Annexure R-1/T) of respondent No.6-Sukhdev Singh, father of petitioner No.1, annexed with the status report, wherein he stated that he had no objection to the marriage solemnized by the petitioners and he would not interfere in their matrimonial life. He further draws the attention of this Court towards the statement (Annexure R-2/T) of petitioner No.1, wherein she stated that they (petitioners) are living happily as husband and wife and there is no threat perception to them.

Keeping in view the fact that grievance of the petitioners has already been redressed, vide order dated 06.10.2020, the present petition has become infructuous.

Disposed of accordingly.
