LISA GILL, J.

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

Prayer in CM No.12515-CWP of 2020 is for allowing the main writ petition in terms of decision dated 13.11.2019 in LPA No.1220 of 2015, titled as State of Haryana and others v. Subhash Chand (Annexure A3).

Notice of the application was issued to the respondents.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the State does not deny that case of the petitioner is covered by the said decision.

With consent of learned counsel for the parties, hearing of the writ petition is preponed from 05.02.2021 for today.

Petitioner has filed this writ petition challenging denial of letter of appointment to him, despite his selection to the post of TGT Sanskrit as per the directions given in the decision dated 04.06.2015 in CWP No.5781 of 2015.

As per the written statement dated 05.01.2016 filed on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2, it is stated as under:-

“8. That, however, the similar controversy has been decided in favour of the petitioner by the Hon’ble High Court vide order dated 04.06.2015 passed in CWP No.5781 of 2015 –Subhash Chand Vs. State of Haryana and others. The Department has challenged above orders of the Hon’ble High Court by way of filing LPA No.1220 of 2015 – State of Haryana and others Vs. Subhash Chand. The Hon’ble High Court has stayed the operation of aforesaid orders of the Hon’ble High Court vide order dated 20.08.2015 passed in LPA No.1220 of 2015, the L.P.A is listed for hearing on 26.11.2015. Copy attached as Annexure R-I.”

Learned counsel for the State is unable to deny that LPA No.1220 of 2015 stand decided on 13.11.2019 whereby the decision dated 04.06.2016 of the learned Single Judge has been upheld.

The case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the said judgment and it is not so disputed by learned counsel for the State.

Keeping in view the aforesaid, application is disposed of and this writ petition is allowed in terms of decision dated 04.06.2015 in CWP No.5781 of 2015 (Annexure P6) as upheld by the Division Bench of this Court on 13.11.2019 in LPA No.1220 of 2015.
