This writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India questioning the correctness of two orders both dated 30.7.2020 (Annexures P-9 and P-10). It may be noted here that the petitioners were appointed as Extension Lecturer on contract basis and they worked on the said post for sometime. Petitioner no.1 worked from 3.9.2013 to 29.3.2014 whereas petitioner no.2 worked from August, 2015 to May, 2017. Both the petitioners claim that they have already completed their Ph.D course in the year 2018. It has been noticed that the writ petitioners filed two separate writ petitions which were disposed of by directing the Director, Higher Education Haryana to pass speaking orders after considering the claim of the petitioners.

During the course of the arguments, Sh. Samarth Sagar, Addl. AG, Haryana, who has appeared pursuant to supply of an advance copy of the writ petition, on instructions from the Deputy Director, Higher Education, Haryana has submitted that there are factual errors in

the orders passed and therefore, the Deputy Director, Higher Education Haryana, be permitted to pass a fresh order after granting opportunity of hearing to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has no objection thereto. In view thereof, the orders dated 30.7.2020 (Annexures P-9 and P-10) are set aside. The Deputy Director, Higher Education Haryana, is requested to pass a fresh speaking order, after granting opportunity of hearing to the petitioners through video conferencing, within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
